## School commitments

- Attend free food growing training in March 2020
- Collect compost available at the training event on **12 March 2020**. Schools that have not previously participated will be provided with a wheelbarrow but will need to purchase their own seeds and/or plug plants (some seeds provided on the training)
- Design and submit a healthy 3 course menu by 20 May 2020 (judging takes place on 21 May 2020)
- Grow at least 5 of your ingredients in the **Mealbarrow**
- Deliver and collect the Mealbarrow to Abbey Pumping Station for the celebration day -Saturday 4 July 2020 (support is available)
- Host the judging team during your site visit to view your Mealbarrow and extended growing area (where available) Visits will be arranged for between 8-12 June 2020.
- Advertise the competition and the celebration day to parents & families via school newsletters and the school's social media channels
