Weekly Challenge 2 Monday 19 July – Sunday 25 July Polar Bears and Climate Change

Polar bears are currently listed as **vulnerable** by the IUCN Red List of Threatened Species, which means they are facing a high risk of extinction in the wild. Climate change caused by human activity is the biggest threat to polar bears as the sea ice they call home is melting and reducing the area they can survive in and depleting food sources.





For your second challenge **REDUCE YOUR CARBON EMISSIONS** by having an **Energy Saving Week.** Use the <u>Energy Saving Challenge</u> worksheet to record your actions.
