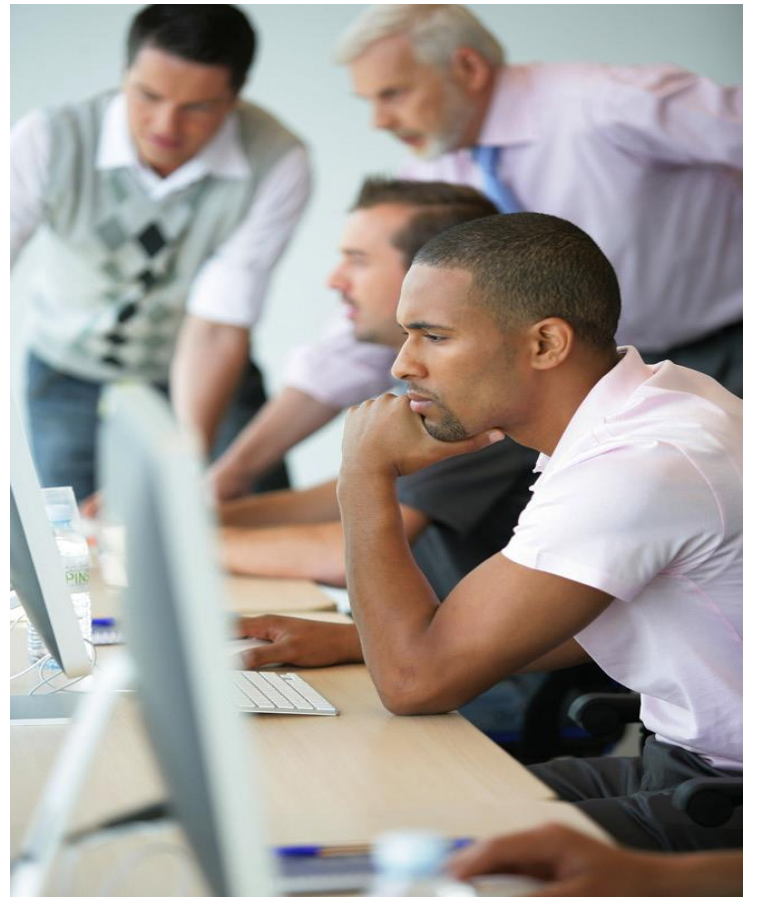
The interactive workshop will cover:
