#### **Rethink Food Tower**

We still have a food tower available for the remainder of this school year!


Rethink Food towers are an innovative way for schools to help teach about the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals whilst looking at growing foods in a sustainable way. The soil-free method increased yields by as much as 30% and triples the speed of growth, while using only 10% of the water and space. The lights on the tower garden allow you to grow plants indoors all year long. There's less hassle and clean up because it doesn't use soil. You can wheel the tower from the classroom to the playground, to the kitchen to the dining room! Get in touch to find out



### COG - recycling audit

Over the past few years through collecting pens, ink cartridges, crisp packages and dental products, COG has saved 2549.6 KG of carbon! This is approximately 4 return flights to New York worth of carbon!





### **Carbon Literacy Project**

To raise awareness of the climate emergency, we are using the Carbon Literacy Project as a way of accrediting school staff to become Carbon Literate.
