Flexi-Schooling

Flexi schooling is a term used to describe an arrangement whereby a child is on a part-time timetable at the request of the parent.

- Schools should consider any requests and may or may not agree
 - it is for the head teacher to decide and this decision will be based on what is felt to be in the best interests of the child
- Where a flexi schooling arrangement is agreed, all relevant sessions of absence should be coded as authorised absence (C)
- Schools are advised to document an arrangement in a written agreement a template is available form the EWS if required
 - It is advisable to include in any agreement that the arrangement will be ended by the school if it is no longer felt to be in the child's best interests
- Any arrangements should be reviewed regularly as with any other part-time timetable
